The 2019 Barbaresco Rombone is a classic Treiso Barbaresco. Strong mineral and spice notes wrap around a core of dark red cherry/plum fruit. It will be interesting to see if the 2019 emerges over time. Today, the Rombone is quite reticent and tightly wound, with bright acids that feel especially prominent within the wine's balance.
